A Tenebrae Service

The service of worship tonight is taken from an early Christian service called Tenebrae. The name Tenebrae is the Latin word for "darkness" or "shadows."

In this service, we will experience only a small portion of Christ's pain and suffering on the day of His crucifixion. One of the most conspicuous features of the service is the gradual extinguishing of candles.

The purpose of the service is to recreate the betrayal, abandonment, and agony of the events of the cross.

The service ends in silence because the story is not over until Easter Day.
