Church Piano

You will notice an addition to the sanctuary this morning in the form of a new piano that replaces the old piano and organ at the front of the auditorium. Over the years a number of you have expressed interest in seeing the church purchase a higher quality piano, and we recently had the opportunity to do so at a reasonable price. The piano was previously owned by a family who is moving to a new home and will no longer have room for it.

We received indications from several persons offering to support the piano purchase with financial contributions designated for that purpose. The total cost of the piano, including moving expense, was \$5,600. We welcome your support in covering the cost of the piano, but do not want funds to be diverted from your regular budget giving. If you would like to make a contribution, we ask that you consider doing so only as a gift in addition to your support for the church budget. Contributions can be made through the Sunday morning offerings, and by marking “piano” on the offering envelope.

Thanks to the Music Committee and Worship Commission for their recommendation to purchase the piano, and their role in having the old piano and organ moved. Thanks also to Carol Palermo for lining up someone to look at the piano and evaluate its condition.
