

He has been the pastor at the Evangelical Church of the Prince of Peace for over 10 years, and just recently, helped the church reach its vision of building a new church in the center of the community. He and his family have opened their home to the community, and they daily welcome those that come for help – medical, physical, emotional and spiritual, as well as financial. Our MAMA teams to San Pedro Sula have partnered with Pastor Juan now for 10 years, as he joins our teams in other communities helping in construction, as well as in his own community, where they open up their church to hold the medical clinics and also help to build houses. Pastor Juan comes from a family of 17 children. From early on, his mother was a big influence on him, as he watched her take care of her family, as well as helping other neighboring families that struggled to survive. He carries that motivation with him today as he walks the mountains around Gracias a Dios, looking to help those with needs, and witnessing to them about the God of Love.
