NEXT SUNDAY -- Service & Picnic in the Park

Peace Valley Service Parking; **Please plan to carpool for our service at the park.** The service starts at **10:00** and you should factor in the following parking considerations as you plan your morning. Parking for about 70 cars is available on site or within a short walking distance. Three handicapped spaces are available. A golf cart will also be on site to shuttle those that need assistance from car to the pavilion area. Drivers should plan to drop off passengers, chairs, food at the pavilion site then follow directions of parking assistants for further parking options. Additional sites obtained for parking include Halteman Plumbing property at the **NE corner of King and Old Limekiln Pike** and Plumstead Christian School - New Galena Campus **located 1.6 miles past the pavilion just across from the park entrance WEST.** (Note speed limit in the park is 25mph.) This lot will hold 70 cars and is paved if weather conditions are not conducive to grass areas drying in the next week. Cars will be available at the designated areas to return drivers to the pavilion area. Thank you for your cooperation in the transportation logistics. We want to be mindful of the community and allow for parking of others that come to enjoy the park and perhaps our service on May 15.
