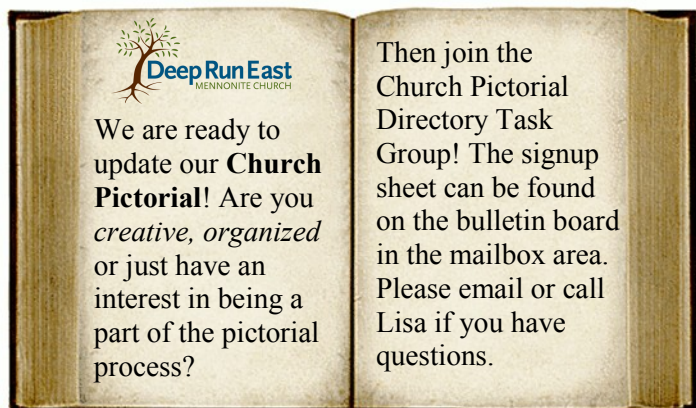

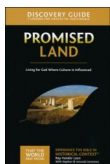

- ~a partnership with children to sensitively challenge them where they are avoidant or frozen in anxiety. The way we talk to our children forms the basis for their inner voices, the way they treat themselves.
