## **The Family Corner**

Faith Begins @ Home By Mark Holmen

“One of the keys to faith-talk is repetition. Do you know what the word “Deuteronomy” means? (It’s okay, neither did I!) It means “repetition of the law.” If you read all of Deuteronomy, you’ll find that Moses continually repeats the basic commands of God to a very stubborn group of people who wanted to live life their own way instead of God’s. Does that sound familiar? Perhaps we need a similar teaching style today in which we continually repeat the basic truths of God to our children.”
