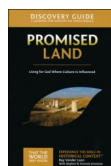

Extended for one more week! **Youth Honduras Team Fundraiser**



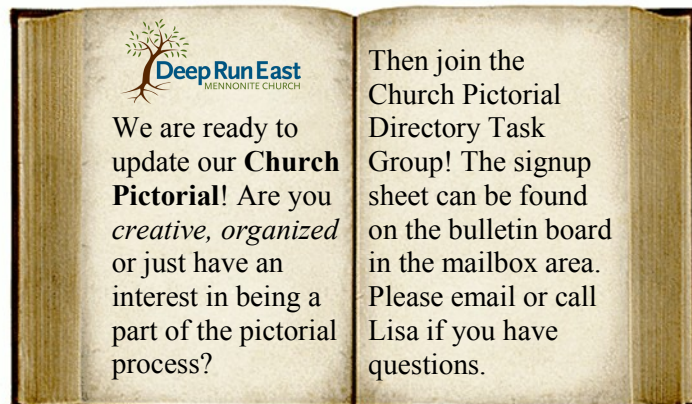
