CLOSE TO HOME Resources

Deep Run East provides a series of helpful pamphlets that are designed to help Christian caregivers invite others to journey toward wholeness. Each pamphlet includes a story of someone who has moved toward healing; basic information about the issue; an explanation of how the Bible and the Christian story address the issue, and encouragement and the next steps on who to talk to and what questions to ask.
