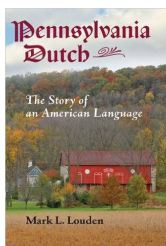


2016 Ministry Volunteer Forms

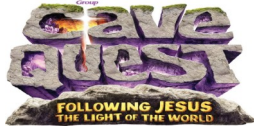
DRE Custodian Update!
