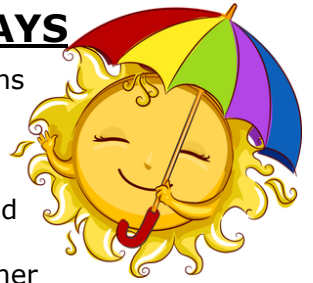


Prayer Requests
