 (No pick-up on Labor Day)**



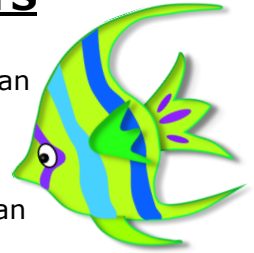

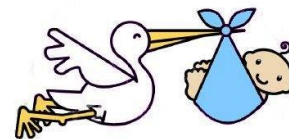
