"DRE Sewing Circle is grateful for the many hours contributed by Tina Yunger, Anna Detweiler, Margaret Leatherman, Lenore Kulp, Ruth Derstine, Anna Rice, Mary Rice, Della Leatherman, Irma Detweiler, Ruth Gahman, Ruth Yothers, Dorothy Leatherman and also those who have already gone on to their eternal reward, but the time has come when they can no longer sit and quilt or knot. The absence of these ladies from our sewing circle has left huge holes. Therefore, we could use some more help. Sewing Circle meets the second Wednesday of each month from about 8:30 AM - 2:30 PM. You are invited to bring a brown bag lunch and join us for the noon meal but you are not required to spend the whole day. Knotters make comforters which are delivered to the Resource Center in Harleysville for distribution as needed around the world. If you can stick a needle through fabric and tie a simple knot, you are qualified to be a knotter. Quilters are stitching on Sewing Circle Day and there are some who stitch on most other Wednesdays (mornings only) as their schedule permits. There is always a quilt set up in the upstairs classroom - grab a friend and put in a few stitches anytime if you are unable to attend on Wednesdays. We also have a need for those who could cut patches and/or stitch patches together. These are not complicated patterns and could be done in your own home.
