“5) Require an answer. This takes some training, but it’s a crucial part of the process. After I have asked my child to do something, I need to wait for their response. I don’t want them to turn and go do it. I want them to verbally agree to the request. I teach my kids to say, “Yes, Mom.” It doesn’t have to be those exact words, but I would caution you against using those “optional” words still. For example, I really prefer that my children not say “ok” as a response to a request that I have made. Saying “ok” means that they agree with it, like it, or want to do it. At first this might not be a problem, but eventually, they won’t always want to do something that I ask them. Then we will run into issues with their response which will lead to disrespectful behavior or attitudes. It’s better from the start to just agree to do it by saying “Yes, Mom” or “Right on it.” Anything but “ok.” Haha.”
